ACCREDITATION - The University of Utah is accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities. Accreditation covers all courses and programs offered at all campuses of the University of Utah. See the general catalog for other accreditations.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR - The University of Utah converted to a semester calendar Fall 1998. A standard semester contains approximately sixteen weeks of instruction, including final examinations. The academic year consists of Fall and Spring semesters with a Summer term.

CREDIT HOURS - A University credit hour represents approximately three clock hours of the student's time a week for one semester. All credit hours beginning Fall semester 1998 are semester hours. Unless otherwise noted, all credit hours through Summer quarter 1998 are quarter hours except Law courses with a # sign in the Units column indicates semester hours.

ACADEMIC STANDING - Student is in "good standing" and eligible for continued enrollment unless otherwise noted. For further information on disciplinary notations, contact the Dean of Students at 801-581-7066.

ACADEMIC AMNESTY - A currently-enrolled, degree-seeking undergraduate student may petition the Academic Advising Center for academic amnesty. This procedure allows the student to request their academic record be reviewed for the purpose of discounting University of Utah courses with a D+ or lower grade that are not being used to fulfill degree requirements on the student's academic record. The courses must have been taken in a maximum of 2 consecutive semesters and after these semesters, the student must have completed a minimum of 30 credit hours with a GPA of 2.0 or greater. If approved, the discounted courses will remain on the student's academic record (and the grades received for the courses will be shown with a message below the course), but the discounted courses and grades received for them will not count towards total hours, cumulative grade point computation, or graduation requirements. The amnesty option can be used only once during a student's undergraduate career. This procedure does not apply to graduate students or to student pursuing a second undergraduate degree.

ACADEMIC RENEWAL - A currently-enrolled, degree-seeking undergraduate student may petition the Academic Advising Center for academic renewal. This procedure allows the student to request their academic record be reviewed for the purpose of discounting University of Utah courses with a D+ or lower grade that are not being used to fulfill degree requirements on the student's academic record. The courses must have been taken four or more calendar years prior to the request. If approved, the discounted courses will remain on the student's academic record (and the grades received for the courses will be shown with a message below the course), but the discounted courses and grades received for them will not count towards total hours, cumulative grade point computation, or graduation requirements. The renewal option can be used only once during a student's undergraduate career. This

procedure does not apply to graduate students or to student pursuing a second undergraduate degree.

TRANSCRIPT NOTES - Prior to Fall 2026, transcript notes appeared at the top of the transcript. Effective Fall 2026, the transcript note will appear in the first term the student enrolled.

DEGREE AND TRANSFER CREDIT - Any information displayed reflecting degrees awarded by, or transfer credit accepted from, other institutions should be verified with the original institution for accuracy. Transfer grades are not computed into the University of Utah's GPA.

COURSE REPEATED - Repeated courses have the following message below the course, "Repeated - Exclude from GPA" for each attempt, except the last attempt, when a course has been repeated. Only the last attempt/grade is computed in the GPA. Beginning Fall 2026, Repeated courses will have the message on each attempt, except the best grade attempt. Only the best grade attempt is computed in the GPA.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE - The grade point average is based on all courses in which the student was enrolled and grade points were earned. The grade point average is calculated by dividing the number of total grade points by the number of total course hours (GPA = TGP/TCH). Credit hours are accumulated in graded courses. Grade points are determined by multiplying the hours for a course by the grade points.
